

Wood Nesting Native Bees



- Australian Native Bees will often take over old beetle holes in dead trees and logs in forest ecosystems.
- It is important to provide a range of safe ecological niches that foster biodiversity.
- Consider preserving or adding wooden nest sites in existing revegetation areas.
